About this Competition:

Do you love wonderful walkways and fantastic footpaths? Have a passion for playspace? Can't get enough of greenery? Go crazy for colour? The Your Streets Your Way competition is your chance to re-design 10 selected street locations across the borough of Lambeth to make spaces that offer joyful journeys and special stopping points.

The competition is open for local people to submit their ideas for up to two of the 10 selected locations. Winning designs will receive cash prize, and one scheme for each site will be built in real life!

You will have the support of a dedicated design team to develop your idea, which will be assessed by a local Judging Panel, made of local community members. A winner will be announced in each location. Each Winner will receive $\pounds750$, there will also be a $\pounds500$ cash prize for the Judge's Choice and a $\pounds200$ (or a $\pounds100$ voucher if you are under the age of 18) Runner Up cash prize for each location too.

Terms and Conditions:

- The competition opens 17th March 2023 and closes 28th April 2023 at 5pm.

- There are 7 competition zones with 10 locations across Lambeth. A winner will be announced in each location. There will be ten winners who each receive £750 and will have their design built. There will also be a £500 cash prize for the Judge's Choice and a £200 Runner Up cash prize for each location too.
- All ages and abilities are welcome to apply. Entrants must be UK based with a UK bank account.
- Restrictions apply to applicants under the age of 18. Winning applicants under the age of 18 will receive a £100 gift voucher, subject to agreement with their legal guardian.
- Each applicant can choose up to two locations and submit 1 design per location.
- This is to make sure that involvement and access to awards is spread as far across the community as possible.
- If the judges suspect that applicants are not acting in the spirit of community competition, and submitting more than the permitted number of applications then we reserve the right to withhold awards and request more details.
- The competition will be judged by people that work every day to make your neighbourhood the best place it can be. They will be looking for a community-led vision that will improve the area for both people and the planet.

- Winners will receive their prizes within a month of the closing date. Any delays will be communicated to the winners if it will take longer.
- The winners will be informed by email within 28 days of the closing date and must respond within 28 days to claim their prize.
- Copyright to the entries will remain with We Made That and Lambeth Council in order to use their photographs and designs to promote street design projects in Lambeth across websites, physical engagement materials and social media as well as to build the design for which they won.
- All submitted materials from winners and other entrants will be used for publicity.

Design tips

- This year we are looking at small scale changes that can be made to the locations, which make a big difference to how they look and feel. Consider whether your design can be light touch with minimal digging and in a shorter time scale.
- Small scale things that you can consider could be:
 - New cycle parking
 - More planting and greenery
 - Small areas of new paving
 - Murals on the ground or walls
 - \circ Sculptures and art works (in locations that are appropriate)
 - Play equipment and play features
 - New signage
 - o Places to sit
- Bins are usually placed in places where people tend to wait or spend time, e.g. bus stops or seating areas
- Lighting is much more complicated than you think! You may add lighting to your design, however it may not be included in the final build. Please highlight in your application if you feel that a location is not appropriately lit and we can ask the teams in the council to do an assessment.

About this location:

297- 299 Coldharbour Lane is a community centre which has been used by the Black and Afro-Caribbean community since the 1980s. The building is being extensively repaired and refurbished by the Council to address major structural issues and improve its general condition. The building is scheduled to reopen to the public in the Summer 2023.

The building was opened as the Brixton Domino and Social Club in 1987 following a UK Government inquiry into the 1981 Brixton Uprisings and the recommendations of the Scarman Report. The building has been home to the Brixton Immortals Domino Club since its opening and has been used by the Brixton Soup Kitchen since 2014. The building was Grade II listed in 1981.

Project Brief:

We believe beautifying the streets can make a positive impact on communities, encouraging everyone to take care of the public spaces. The final design wants to create a design which aims to enhance the beauty of this corner.



When designing it is important to remember to make sure the space can be used by all, including those with disabilities, older people and people with buggies. Have a think about how the space is used during the day and in the night and how that might influence your design as well as any elements you may want to add.

Considerations:

- The design aims to create an inviting place for the community
- Your design can include painting and/or installations
- It can include changes to the pavement and/or installation of further elements
- The design proposed must maintain clear space for people to walk and wheel
- The design proposed can include additional features if needed
- Existing fittings e.g. bins can be part of the design


